Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Support

Providing support to link Indigenous people to local services to meet their individual and family needs.

Alcohol and Drug Treatment

Continence Nursing Service

Assists you, your family and/or carers to better manage your bladder and bowel health. Individual & group programs are available.

Counselling & Mental Health Support

We have a range of mental health services for everyone of any age including gamblers help, grief and loss, relationships, mental health recovery support and group programs.

Diabetes Education

Specialise in the provision of self management education and skill training for people with diabetes.

Dietitians

Can support healthy eating, diet modifications to treat specific conditions, cooking skills, meal planning, reading food labels and food budgeting.

Doctors

Gateway Health Medical Practices are located in Wangaratta and Wodonga. Men's Behaviour Change

Assistance for those over 18 years of age who have been involved in family violence.

McGrath Breast Care Nurse

If you are a male who has been diagnosed with primary or secondary breast cancer, this program can give you and your family support and education in conjunction with Oncologists.

Parenting and Relationship Services

Offering a wide range of parenting and relationship education delivered through group programs and individual one on one support for young parents, parents grandparents and carers.

Podiatry

Provides foot and nail care, nail surgeries and orthotics, footwear education and wound management.

Positive Parenting Telephone Service

Offering a self-directed individualised parenting program to families with children aged from 2 to 10 who live within the Hume Region in Victoria. Both day time and evening appointments available.

Registered Nurses

Sexual health, immunisations, health checks and more.
